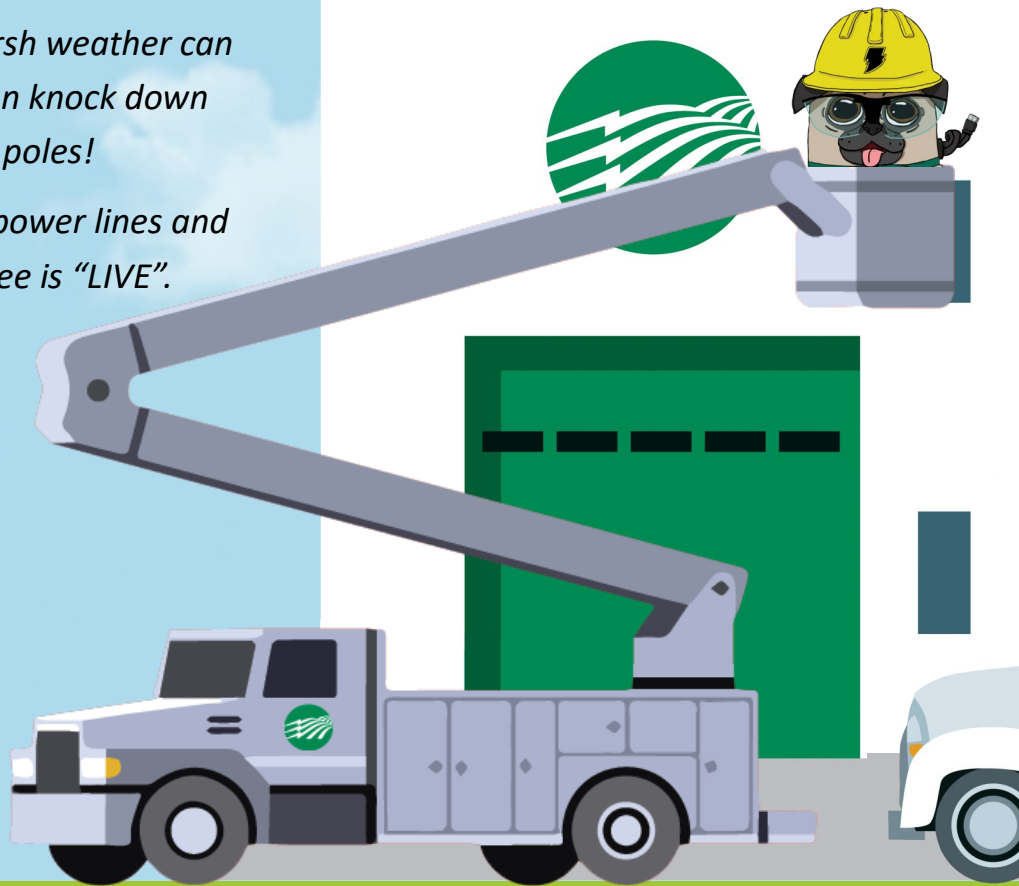


Lineman Larry and Pluggy are here to teach us about how electricity travels to our homes and schools!

But sometimes, strong winds or harsh weather can cause trees to fall down, which can knock down power lines or even utility poles!

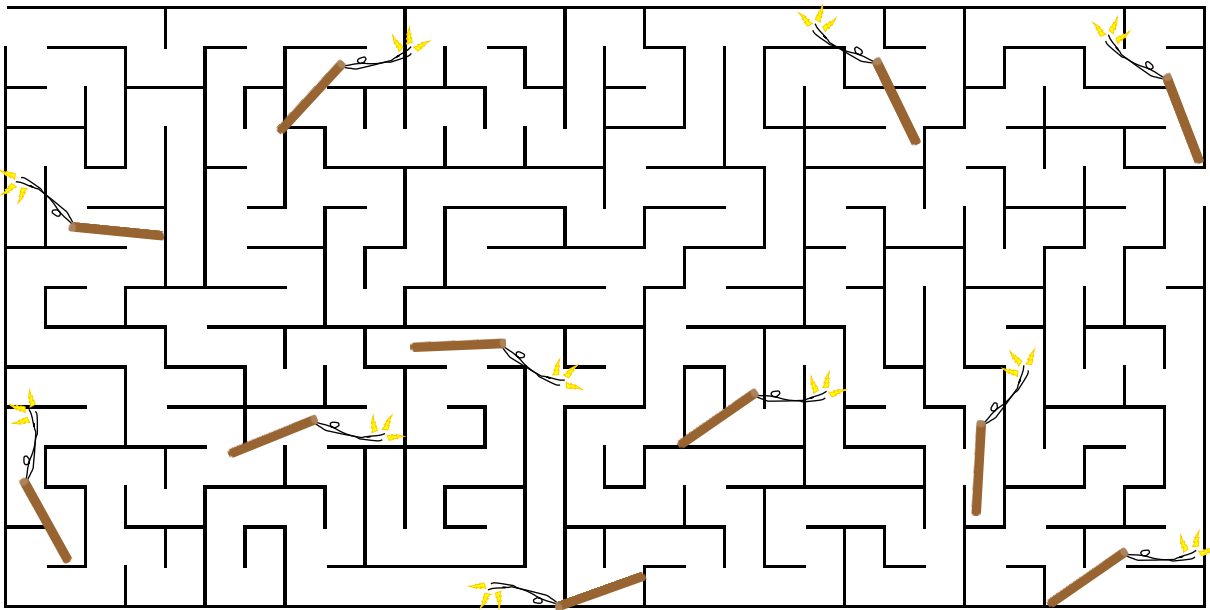
You should never go near downed power lines and ALWAYS assume any wire you see is "LIVE".

Navigate through the maze below so you can get home without touching any downed power lines!



SAFETY TIP

Downed power lines can energize the ground up to 35 feet around them, even if they aren't sparking. Because of this, you should also avoid making contact with anything that may be touching the downed wire such as a car, a tree, or a nearby chain link fence. Electricity can travel through these objects and hurt you! Stay Clear, Stay Safe!
