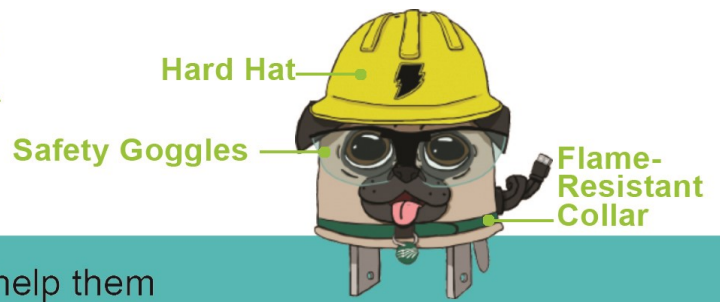


# GEARED FOR SAFETY

5. These keep debris away from lineworkers' eyes while on the job.

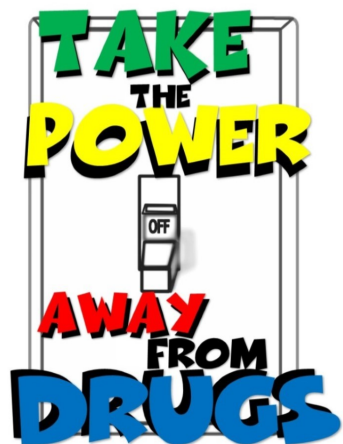
